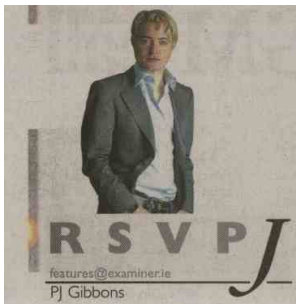




Chamber lunch a big success
